After numerous discussions and reviewing replacement tractor options we have decided to purchase another New Holland T6 tractor from Swiderski Equipment, with identical track system that we had. We seriously looked at a similar sized John Deere tractor but there was enough of a price difference we felt we needed to go with the New Holland as we needed to also replace the brush mower lost in the tractor fire. To purchase an identically equipped 2022 tractor as we purchased in December of 2020 for \$215,000 today cost just over \$300,000 due to inflation.

We do want to thank everyone who has been helping get us back on our feet with the urgently needed trail brushing that the tractor fire ended. We have an urgent need to get done before the season starts without interfering with the Deer hunting season. Due to used groomer tractor appreciation (inflation) West Bend Insurance along with the help of our agent, Klinner Insurance, they were able to pay us out for the full coverage amount we had on the tractor. Also until our new tractor is available, Swiderski Equipment has given us the use of a tracked tractor for the brushing work we had since fallen behind on. Also, Reisetere and Schneel is letting us demo a used heavy duty brush mower they just got in on trade. As of Friday the 28<sup>th</sup>, we are back out mowing trails, especially those that had been previously opened up with the excavator and tree shear. The days of all manual and somewhat dangerous hand labor to brush trails is behind us. There is just too much continuous need for brushing that manual labor just cannot keep up with the needs.
