Thanks to the people who have contacted us as volunteers to help with club activites and work. We have been out working on trails with directors and volunteers and as always there is always work to be done considering the 150 miles of snowmobile trail we manage. We have been out mowing trails with the new tractor as well as fixing wet spots, installing and resetting culverts and some brushing.

We are looking for people with UTVs and ATVs that are willing to combine trail riding with some trail work. The 80 miles of combination ATV/UTV trails we have get graded or dozed every summer and with many of the rocky trails we have, the work generates stones on sides of trails that when buried in the winter snow is not good or the grooming equipment, or potentially your snowmobiles. We also have new tree and brush growth that is sometime too high to reach, even with our boom mower. The club has cordless pole saws that are available for trail work.

Basically we are looking for volunteers to ride trails and watch for problems such as signs missing or added to improve safety, or to be fixed or reset, or whatever you may be capable of helping and improving our trails. The club can get reimbursed for any donated work, and for the equipment used. The hourly rate is only \$9.00 per hour per man, but every little bit helps so keep track of your time and equipment used and on the trail system the work is done.

We are only working on the public land trails and not on private land due to seasonal hunting. If you are available and can offer some help, contact Fred Schauer, Dennis Stenz or Eddie Miller and we will assist in showing you where to focus and what equipment we have for you to borrow.
